



Mary M. Hogan: String Churn Dash Workshop

Some background fabric and some strings of fabric sew up quickly into Churn Dash (also known as Monkey Wrench) blocks. No worries about points. Using strings of fabric leads to really interesting blocks. Yours will be unlike any others. In class you will learn how to make Churn Dash blocks. Making two or three will give you a nice size table runner.

Save your spot now. The class will be held in the **Beechwood Lodge** on **Tuesday, June 25, 2019** from 9:00 AM to 3:00 pm. Lodge will be open at 8:30 AM for set up.

The cost of the class is \$40.00 for members and \$50.00 for non- members. Your payment in full insures your place in the class until the limit of 20 has been reached. Non-guild members will be admitted after June 01, 2019.

Materials Supply List:

Background fabric for (3) blocks: *(cut prior to class)*

- * $\frac{3}{4}$ yard fabric
- * Cut (4) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch X WOF strips
- * Cut (7) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares from each strip (27)

Contrasting fabric for blocks: *(do NOT cut prior to class)*

- * About 1 yard of assorted fabric pieces. Having a small amount of many fabrics is more important than having a specific amount of any particular fabric.
- * We will be cutting strings/strips in class. Do not cut before class; but feel free to bring fabric strings and scraps if you have them.

Backing and binding fabric (will not be used in class): About 1 yard

Batting (will not be used in class): A piece that is about 20" X 50"
