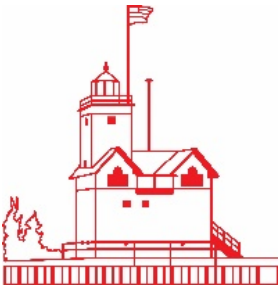


# **Big Red Quilters' Guild Presents**

## ***Basic Fabric Dyeing Workshop***

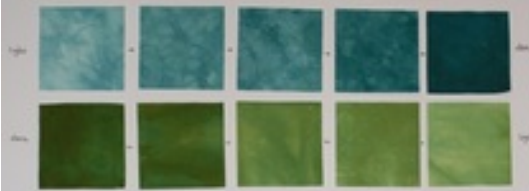
**Friday, April 19, 2019, 9 am - noon**

In this class we will go through several exercises to create your own colorful cloth. You will learn several different techniques for using the MX Fiber Reactive dyes with low water immersion. We will talk about the color wheel so that you have a basic understanding of combining colors before mixing them in the exercises. I am happy to help mix a color, however the specific shade to match your project might not be possible because of the colors used in class. The three exercises include making a light to dark gradation of a single color, making a color to color gradation to find the colors that lie between, and experimenting with pre-soda-soaked fabric. The participant can choose to make a single color ombre, a rainbow piece or all-over multi-colored piece. 2 Kit options are available as well as a required supply list.

# Basic Fabric Dyeing:

## Exercise 1: Value Gradation

In this exercise we will create a 5 step gradation of one color. You choose a hue from the color wheel to dye.



## Exercise 2: Color Gradation

In this exercise we will create a 5 step gradation from one color to another color. You choose the colors and order.



## Exercise 3: Multi-Color piece

In this exercise you have to dye multiple colors on one piece of fabric, in order and in different gradations. Great choice!
